

## OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

The Tau Lekoa Mine Management team recognises that excellence in managing health and safety forms an integral part of its business. The Management team remains committed to provide a working environment conducive to the health and safety of the workforce. Concurrent to this Tau Lekoa Mine embraces all aspects of the AngloGold Health and Safety policy.

To this effect Tau Lekoa Mine applies a comprehensive Risk Management approach with the overall objective of **continually reducing the known significant risks** to a level as low as reasonably practicable.

The following risks have been identified by Tau Lekoa Mine and are regarded as significant in terms of Occupational Health and Safety:

- Risks that give rise to **fall of ground** incidents
- Risks associated with **vertical transport**
- Risks associated with **flammable gas**
- Risks associated with **horizontal transport**
- Risks associated with **silica dust and noise** exposures
- Risks that give rise to underground and surface **fires**
- Risks associated with **hydropower**
- Risks associated with the transport and handling of **explosives**
- Risks associated with **flooding**

Other risks as could be identified as part of the total process will be managed in accordance with the Risk Management strategy. The abovementioned risks are managed in terms of the OHSAS 18001 specification.
